**Trust Guidelines for all schools within Bishop Hogarth Catholic Education Trust**

**The Government has announcement that our School is now in Tier 2**

**The following arrangements are in place from 14 October 2020**

- The school will keep visitors to an absolute minimum, and only those with a key role will be able to visit (health workers etc)
- All staff and children from KS2 upwards will be expected to wear a face covering when in school, but outside the classroom.
- Face covering for KS1 remains optional and at the discretion of the parents/guardians.
- Children will be expected to provide their own mask and we will provide a zip lock bag they can safely store it away when not in use.
- If a child has a medical condition, eg asthma, that makes wearing a mask difficult, parents will be given the choice for the child not to wear a mask.
- All parents/guardians will be asked (where possible) to wear a face covering when dropping off and picking up their children from school.

We hope that this reassures parents/guardians that the safety and care of children is our greatest priority.
